ALL LAWS WILL BE ENFORCED. VIOLATORS ARE SUBJECT TO PENALTIES AND FINES UP TO \$3000 AND 90 DAYS IN JAIL.



Chapter 175: BRUSH, WEEDS, UNCUT GRASS AND DEBRIS

All garbage, trash, grass, weeds, brush, dead and dying trees, stumps, roots and debris shall be placed in the appropriate containers and disposed of by the owner.



Chapter 203: DOGS AND OTHER ANIMALS

No person shall allow any dog or other animal to be left outdoors if the dog or other animal engages in periods of sustained barking, howling, crying or other loud noises especially, but not limited to, the hours of 10:00 pm to 7:00 am.



Chapter 259: GARAGE SALES AND HOUSE SALES

All sales require a permit. No more than 2 permits will be issued in a 12 month period.



Chapter 273: HOUSING STANDARDS

It shall be the duty of the owner or operator to keep the premises free of nuisances, unsightly conditions, unsanitary conditions or hazards.



Chapter 283: ILLEGAL OCCUPANCIES AND CONVERSIONS

It shall be unlawful for an owner or landlord of a building to allow occupancy of a basement, attic, garage, or any room considered to be an illegal conversion. Most basements and attics are illegal for sleeping.



Chapter 307: LITTERING

No person shall throw or deposit litter in or upon any street, sidewalk or public place. Litter shall be placed in the proper container and disposed of by the owner.



Chapter 327: NOISE

It is the policy of the City of Clifton to prevent excessive sound that may jeopardize the health, welfare, safety or degrade the quality of life of citizens especially, but not limited to, the hours of 10:00 pm to 7:00 am.



Chapter 331: NUISANCES

Any noise of such intensity or duration as to be detrimental to the life, health or welfare of any individual or which disturbs the comfort, repose, peace or safety of any individual is hereby prohibited especially, but not limited to, the hours of 10:00 pm to 7:00 am.



Chapter 347: PARKING TRUCKS, TRAILERS AND BUSES

Between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. every day, it shall be unlawful to park an omnibus, school bus, school vehicles, pole trailer, road tractor, trailer, semi trailer, truck tractor, tow truck on any street, highway, or public place in the City of Clifton.



Chapter 355: PEACE AND GOOD ORDER

No person shall loiter especially while under the influence of liquor or any unlawful substance in any street, public or private property that causes public inconvenience, annoyance or alarm.



Chapter 383: SNOW AND ICE, REMOVAL OF

All residents shall remove snow and ice from sidewalks within 12 hours after a snowfall.



Chapter 403: SWIMMING AND SWIMMING POOLS

Cover pools to prevent unsanitary conditions. Any unnecessary or loud noise in or about any private pool including radios, recording devices, etc., which annoys or disturbs the peace, quiet and comfort of others is prohibited. Fence with locked gate required.
