## Food/Drug/Pet Recall: Raw Oysters

The Canadian Food Inspection Agency has expanded the recall of raw oysters from British Columbia, Canada.

The original recall mentioned in the 4/5/22 LINCS message includes:

Raw oysters with potential Norovirus contamination from Baynes Sounds, British Columbia. The harvest locations include: #1407063, #1411206, #278737 in BC 14-8 and #1400036, in BC 14-15. "Baynes Sound" will show on product tags as "14-8" and/or "DEEP BAY", or "14-15."

The expanded recall includes:

A total of 320 dozen deep water small Pacific raw oysters from Mac's Oysters, Ltd., Fanny Bay, British Columbia, for E. coli contamination. The oysters are from BC 14-8, Metcalf Bay and were harvested on 3/30/2022. Fanny Bay also appears on the tags. A total of 20 dozen oysters were distributed by Lockwood and Winant Seafood, LLC, Bronx, NY. Marinelli Shellfish, San Francisco, CA also distributed 300 dozen of these oysters. Although direct distribution was not reported, the oysters still may be in New Jersey retail establishments.

No illnesses have been reported in association with these recalls. During routine inspections, LHDs are advised to check if retail establishments have the above-mentioned raw oysters.
