OBC Group Corp Recalls Indian Walnut Seed Products and Capsules Due To Potential Health Risks

OBC GROUP CORP of Miami, FL is recalling its NUT DIET MAX Nut seeds and capsules because an FDA analysis has determined that the products appear to be Thevetia peruviana or yellow oleander. All parts of the yellow oleander plant are known to contain cardiac glycosides that are highly toxic to humans and animals. Ingestion of yellow oleander can cause adverse neurological, gastrointestinal and cardiovascular health effects that can be serious or even fatal. Symptoms can include nausea, vomiting, dizziness, diarrhea, abdominal pain, heart rhythm changes, arrhythmia, and more.

The seeds were distributed online through the Amazon and eBay platforms. The product comes in a 2-ounce clear bag. The INDIAN NUT capsules were distributed online through Ebay and Walmart platforms. The capsules come in an amber bottle with 30 capsules.

No disease has been reported so far.

The recall was the result of sampling by the FDA.

Consumers who purchased cashew seeds from NUT DIET MAX are urged not to consume them and return them to the place of purchase for a full refund. Consumers with questions can contact the company at 1-305-216-1322. Monday through Friday from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm Eastern Time.
